Grades and/or transcripts cannot be released nor can a student register for future terms with an outstanding account balance.

## SELF- ENROLLMENT BEGINS MARCH 17th.

The first step is for you to contact your faculty advisor directly to make an appointment for advising during the week of March 2nd. You will meet with your advisor and complete a Registration Form. You will then use that Registration Form to go online and register for your courses beginning on your designated day/time. MANDATORY ADVISING is required to be able to self-enroll. An "Academic Advising Hold" has been placed on your account and will be removed once you have met with your advisor. As always, you will not be able to self-enroll with any type of hold on your account.

Please check your "Student Services Center" tab on the Pitt portal at my.pitt.edu for your enrollment appointment date and time. Once your appointment begins, you can continue self-enrolling through the add/drop period. Appointments have been assigned according to credits earned with seniors given the earliest appointments.

Continue to watch the Student Services area of the portal for additional information. A video will be available to assist students with the self-enrollment process.

When attempting to register for classes, if you are unable to add a particular class because it is closed or it requires instructor consent you must still obtain written permission on your Registration Form from the instructor to add the course and then bring the Registration Form to Enrollment Services to process.

### **COURSE TYPES**

**WEB=** feature web-based instruction and interaction.

Students interact with their instructors and other students through the class web site, participating in online discussions and activities.

**HYBRID=** combines web-based interaction and some to-face instruction or interaction. Students are required to attend scheduled meetings or classes and participate in online discussions and activities.

**ITV=** offered via interactive television and broadcast from Bradford to another location.

## **Descriptions for Selected Fall 2009 Courses:**

(Descriptions for all other courses found in the Pitt-Bradford catalog)

**ADMJ 1430 Criminal Forensics II (3)** This course will allow students to demonstrate advanced criminal forensic investigative skills. Students will focus on several types of advanced indoor and outdoor crime scene scenarios, specifically concentrating on violent criminal investigations. The various scenarios will include multiple homicides, criminal profiling; sex-related homicides; homicides made to appear as accidents; homicides made to appear as suicides; handling buried body cases; murder-suicide; infant abductions & SID cases.

**CIST 1450 Special Topics: Business Intelligence (3)** Today's organizations have relied much upon large amount of data in day-to-day operations. How to turn the wealth of data into business value becomes a critical issue for managers, IT professionals, and other decision makers. This course focuses on Business Intelligence, which provides methods to organize, process, manage, and analyze data for better decision making in a business environment. Topics covered in this class include data modeling, database design, data analysis using SQL, analytics in decision making, and implementation and application of business intelligence tools.

**ECON 0250 Special Topics: Global Hunger (3)** This course examines the causes of famines and its relevance to the current global food crisis, generated through high food prices, food supply security and climate change. Policy analysis will explore the debates surrounding Genetically Modified Crops, WTO agreements and property rights.

**HMGT 0220 Foodservice Management (3)** Foodservice systems will be explored through examining the component parts of a typical foodservice operation. This component parts include: management and organization, procurement, production, distribution, service, maintenance, and sanitation. The course will also explore modern trends in foodservice/restaurant management. All students will be required to sit for the Servsafe Sanitation Certification exam as preparation for upper level food courses.

**HMGT 1330 Principles of Food Preparation (4)** A study of the various foods, production principles, cooking methods, food storage and equipment utilized in food preparation. Includes both lab and classroom learning opportunities. The classroom component provides the theoretical basis of food types and production processes that will then be demonstrated and experimented with in the lab environment. Requires the purchase of professional uniform and some supplies.

**HMGT1380 Special Events Planning (3)** This course introduces students to special event planning processes and techniques. Emphasis is on creating, organizing, identifying sponsors, marketing and implementing large scale community events.

**IA 0101 Arts Awareness (3)** This arts seminar course encourages an integrated exploration and analysis of arts events. The course is taught in the hybrid format in which students attend a weekly seminar, engage in online course activities, and attend arts events. An important focus of the course is on various interdisciplinary approaches to the arts. Several events are made available for the students each term through the college's Spectrum Series. *GE: Arts*

**MGMT 1450 Special Topics: Race, Gender and Employment (3)** This course looks at the Human Relations and legislative and policy responses to labor force issues of racial and gender inequality. The course will also examine the social, ethical, legal, economic, equity and diversity issues among organizations and individuals. This course will help develop knowledge and skills for dealing with these issues within organizations.

**PSY 1448 Special Topics: Environmental Psychology (3)** Environmental psychology is concerned with the impact of environmental variables on human thought, experience, and behavior. The interaction between environments (natural, social settings, built, learning, and informational) and human behavior will be examined. The field is interdisciplinary, with roots in psychology, architecture, art, geography, anthropology, sociology, and urban planning. This course is a survey of theories and findings that have been generated by environmental scientists.

### **WRITNG 0111 Literary Editing/Magazine Production I (3)**

An introductory seminar in the philosophical and practical issues of magazine production. Students will work in practical situations to become acquainted with the field of literary editing and magazine production including production values, editing practices, proofreading, layout and design, preparation of text, publicity, and promotion. Coursework will include researching and studying the history and traditions of literary magazines and examining ethical issues related to print media.

**WRITNG 0211 Literary Editing/Magazine Production II (3)** An intermediate seminar in the philosophical and practical issues of magazine production. Students will continue work begun in literary editing and magazine production I, further developing skills and knowledge of production values, editing practices, proofreading, layout and design, preparation of text, publicity, and promotion. Coursework will include researching and studying the history and traditions of literary magazines and examining ethical issues related to print media.

### **WRITNG 1311 Literary Editing/Magazine Production III (3)**

An advanced seminar in the philosophical and practical issues of magazine production. Students will continue work begun in literary editing and magazine production I, further developing skills and knowledge of production values, editing practices, proofreading, layout and design, preparation of text, publicity, and promotion. Coursework will include advanced work in layout and design.

## SCHOLARS CIRCLE

### **We'll help you develop talents for life-long learning.**

Scholars Circle courses create an environment that stimulates learning and empowers students to take responsibility for their education – habits that extend throughout your lifetime.

### **Gain skills for communication and research.**

Courses stress student writing and participatory learning. Students will critically engage and synthesize class materials and be better equipped to communicate with others, both orally and in writing.

### **Develop an understanding of the human experience across cultures and through time with emphasis on human curiosity, expression, creativity, and moral dilemmas.**

Students will have the opportunity to reflect upon how cultural circumstances shape our understanding, knowledge, and assumption. Many of the courses in the Scholars Circle are in general education.

**In order to register for Scholars courses you must have a 3.25 overall GPA or have taken Scholars courses previously. Once you have the appropriate permission to take these courses you will need Enrollment Services to add the classes for you.**
